







In view of the above facts, you are requested to forward the circulars to all affiliated schools under your jurisdiction with immediate effects.





Sir/Madam,

The National Innovation Foundation (NIF), an autonomous body of the Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India aims to recognize and respect and reward grassroots technological innovators and traditional knowledge experts. In order to promote originality and creativity among school children NIF organizes the IGNITE- Nationwide Competition of the students' original technological ideas and innovations.

The last date for accepting entries for Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam IGNITE Competition 2017 is August, 31st, 2017. The award is announced on 15th October, 2017, the birthday of Bharat Ratna, former President of India Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam celebrated as Children's Creativity and Innovation Day.

NIF files patents in all applicable cases in the name of the students and develops prototypes of the students' ideas for the award exhibition.

The NIF's IGNITE award winners are eligible to get 10 bonus marks while applying for admission in B. Tech. Program at Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology Delhi (IIITD), an autonomous institute of the Government of India. These bonus marks are in addition to the 100 marks an applicant gets based on the JEE (Main) and class XII marks.
