RASHIDPURA PYAJ Drought Tolerant Onion Variety

GENESIS

Shri Manaram had developed an improved and high yielding variety of onion through selection method. Initial material was collected from local variety.

DISTINCT FEATURES

- Rashidpura onion can also be taken as a winter crop as it is highly adaptable to varying climatic conditions
- Higher yield (40,000 kg bulbs per hectare) as compared to average yield (25,000-30,000 kg per hectare) of commercially cultivated varieties
- Delicious taste as compared to commercially cultivated local varieties
- Early maturing (110-115 days) as compared to the normally cultivated varieties (125-135 days)
- The variety developed by the farmer requires less irrigation and can thrive well under drought conditions

SUITABLE CLIMATE

 Cool season crop, (Mild climate is most suitable), Annual rainfall requirement is 750 to 1000 mm/year

OTHER FEATURES

- Storage / Good Shelf life
- Life Span : Seasonal crop
