

NIF engages with Farmers at “Apna Parisar, Apne Beej” Workshop

The National Innovation Foundation - India (NIF) actively engaged with farmers and community representatives during the two-day workshop titled “Apna Parisar, Apne Beej” (Our Landscape, Our Seeds), organized by REEDS in collaboration with Yojak.

During the workshop, the NIF team undertook extensive documentation of indigenous crop varieties, including millets, maize, paddy, oilseeds, and vegetables, from the tri-state regions of Dang, Nandurbar, and Alirajpur. The team also conducted a technical session focusing on the conservation of indigenous seeds and the promotion of grassroots innovations.
